## ESRD NETWORK RESPONSE

**Facility Tracking** - ESRD Networks have access to this website to track the status of open/closed facilities in affected areas for any level of emergency response. Information will be updated as the Network receives notifications from provider facilities.

**Patient and Provider Assistance** – The Network will monitor phone lines during an emergency event if service is operational. Network staff will answer calls as available or informational status messages will be recorded and updated periodically.
